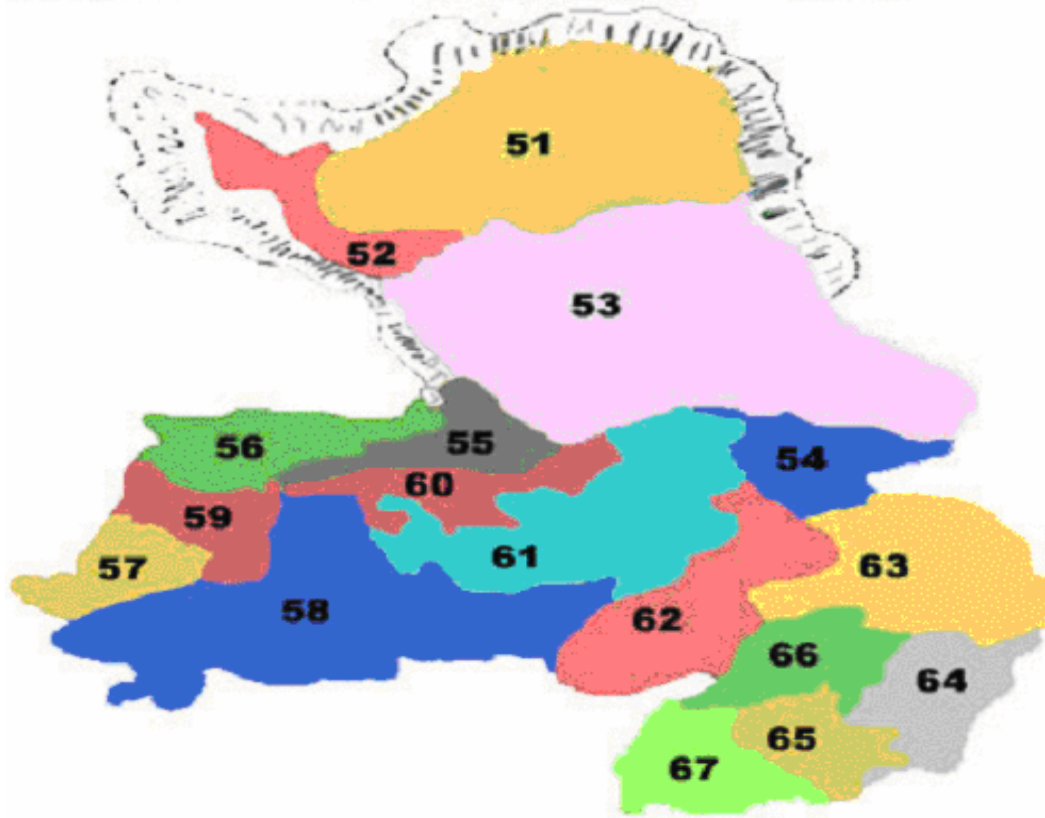

10. BEGINNING OF POLL PROCESS

1. ENFORCEMENT OF MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

- a) A meeting of the District Officers and political parties has been convened and they have been directed to ensure full compliance with the directions received from the Election Commission Of India in letter and spirit.
- b) A Complaint Register has been opened giving details of the complaints received. The complaints are being followed vigorously, and results of enquiries/verifications have been communicated to the CEO. Some are being processed replies will be sent shortly.
- c) All Political parties in the district have been made aware of the provision of the J&K Prevention of Defacement of Public Property Act and the provisions of the Model Code of Conduct wherein no political party can deface Government property and cannot use election material on any individual's property without his permission.
This aspect of the MCC is being complied with fully and all hoardings and banners showing the photographs of ministers/ achievements of the party in power have been removed. Wherever there is a repetition of the act, necessary action shall be initiated against the political parties concerned.
- d) All District Officers have been directed to refrain from any political activity and direct their staff accordingly in order to ensure complete transparency and neutrality in the elections.

ELECTION CELL AND MEDIA CENTRE

An Election Cell has been constituted in the Deputy Commissioner's Office under Head Quarter Assistant to DC, supported by 10 officials drawn from different departments at the district level., which is working from 10am to 10pm.

A complaint cell has also been constituted to look after the election related complaints and issue of permissions for holding public meetings and rallies and use of loud speakers.

Similarly the Election Cells at all the Tehsil HQs established under the control of concerned SDMs/Tehsildars.

A Media Centre has been opened in the District Information Office, with the District Information Officer being incharge of the cell. A telephone connection is in place and other necessary renovation is being carried out. The media center has been given the list of polling stations, copy of electoral rolls and all other information necessary for dissemination of information to the general public and political parties. It will also register complaints if any with regard to the election process.

Help Line for enquiry of Electoral Roll related issues has been established at the office of the District Information Officer, Kathua.
